GAME AND PARKS COMMISSION

Description:

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES CAN APPLY FOR A PERMIT TO HUNT AND FISH FROM A VEHICLE ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. INDIVIDUALS UNABLE BY REASON OF PHYSICAL INFIRMITIES TO HUNT AND FISH IN A NORMAL MANNER MAY BE ISSUED A SPECIAL PERMIT. ANY PERSON WHO IS AGE 70 OR OVER, AND A RESIDENT OF NEBRASKA, OR A VETERAN AGED 65 OR OVER SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PAYMENT OF ANY FEES FOR FISHING. PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES WHO WISH TO HUNT ARCHERY DEER, ANTELOPE OR TURKEY WITH A CROSSBOW, MUST ATTEST THE LOSS OF USE OF AN ARM THROUGH AMPUTATION OR LACK OF USE OF AN ARM THROUGH PERMANENT IMPAIRMENT WHICH RENDERS THE INDIVIDUAL INCAPABLE OF DRAWING A LONG BOW.

Eligibility:

A FORM MUST BE FILLED AND SENT TO THE LINCOLN OFFICE FOR APPROVAL AND ISSUANCE. FOR THE CROSSBOW PERMIT, THE INDIVIDUAL MUST HAVE LOST THE USE OF AN ARM THROUGH AMPUTATION OR LACKS USE OF AN ARM THROUGH PERMANENT IMPAIRMENT WHICH RENDERS HIM INCAPABLE OF DRAWING A LONG BOW. PERMIT TO HUNT AND FISH FROM VEHICLE IF YOU CANNOT FISH IN A NORMAL MANNER. VETERANS-FREE HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE. A COPY OF A PHYSICIAN'S STATEMENT MUST BE SUBMITTED EACH TIME.
